The price reported is a weighted average price. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$180.15 to \$180.56, inclusive. - any security holder of the issuer or the staff of the Securities and Exchange Commission, upon request, full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the range 6. Each performance right represents a contingent right to receive one share of the issuer's common stock at vesting. The performance rights vest in three equal amounts, at a rate between 0% and 200%, during
